### **Constitutional Amendment - Board Member Eligibility**

The Ameraucana Breeders Club has welcomed all who wish to learn more, are breeding/raising, or would like to start breeding/raising Ameraucana chickens. We encourage our members, or those that would like to become members, to research information, find mentors, and share their experiences through every means possible.

That may include being a member of another breed club that also has as its focus, the Ameraucana breed. We have many members now that are members of both the ABC and the Alliance and we're happy that we're able to share our experiences, knowledge, and joys/heartbreak of breeding across club lines.

When a member becomes a part of the Board, the level of their activity within the Club changes and should be more focused on the ABC. The job of any Board member is to promote the ABC, encourage/mentor new members, and strive to foster growth and stability within the Club.

With that in mind, and after much discussion, the Board is proposing the following changes to the Constitution and By-laws. Please read, review, and feel free to comment.

The affected paragraphs, as they currently read:

#### Article III - District Directors

The District Directors shall be responsible for actively promoting the club and its' activities, including the placing of an annual District meet within their individual districts. They shall also represent the club, place all district, state, and special meets within their district and report the results of meets within their district in the quarterly district report submitted to the secretary/treasurer for publication in the quarterly bulletin, and carrying out

details for the National meet when held within their district. Each District Director shall serve as an officer on the Board of Directors, have a vote in determining club policy, assist with coordinating club meets within their district, and take an active part in the recruitment of new members.

#### **Constitutional Amendment - Election Commissioners**

With the advent of online voting, and the additional security and anonymity it provides, the ABC is moving forward with an online election application, Election Buddy. Election buddy will send out emails to the registered voters (all active members with an email address), providing a link to the election. At the end of the election, Election Buddy tallies the votes and returns a report that gives the totals for each portion of the election. No one, not even the admin that sets up the election in election buddy, knows who voted for whom.

There are some members who prefer to do things the back-to-basics way with a printed ballot and an address to mail it in to. For those members, election buddy prints out a coded ballot (to avoid duplication of voting) and our President will name an Election Commissioner to tally those votes and turn in a report at the end of the election. Since those ballots do not have a name, not even the mail-in Election Commissioner will know who voted for whom.

There are a few changes in the Constitution to make these changes official and you will be seeing this as an option on this year's ballot.

Here is how it reads now:

Article V - Election Commissioner

An Election Commissioner shall be appointed by the president. The Commissioner shall receive all ballots directly from the membership, tally them, and promptly forward the results and the ballots to the Secretary/Treasurer.

And, the proposed changes

Article V - Election Commissioner

Election Commissioner(s) shall be appointed by the President: (Add - one for electronic online voting and one for mail-in paper ballots). The Commissioner(s) shall receive all ballots, from the source assigned to them, directly from the membership, tally them, and promptly forward the results (Remove "and the ballots") to the Secretary/Treasurer.

Both Election Commissioners, electronic and paper, are required to provide a full tally of votes for each item in the election. Neither electronic or paper ballots, with voters' names attached, shall be shared with anyone, nor information about how any member voted be shared. All votes shall remain anonymous.

Last year, the Board approved a plan to permit those joining in the last quarter of the year, to pay a prorated dues amount, if they paid for the following year at the same time. That seemed to work very well,

	but in order to keep doing that, we would need to change some wording in our Constitution. Here is what it says now:
	Article IV – Dues Annual dues shall be set by the Board of Directors and shall be payable on January 1st for each calendar year.

	Article V – Organization Section 1. The officers comprising the Board of Directors shall consist of the following: President Secretary/Treasurer District Directors
	Section 2. Officers shall be elected by a majority vote of the membership to a term of two years beginning on the first day of January following election. Any officer may be a candidate for reelection.

Open positions on the Board of Directors shall be filled by a person selected by the President and approved by majority vote of the Board of Directors.

The following Section would be added:

Section 4.

Should the President be unable to fulfill his or her duties, he can appoint a successor from the current Board members. That person must be approved by a majority vote of the Board. If the Board is unable to approve the appointee or the President is unable to appoint a successor, then the order of succession would be as follows:

- 1. District Director from the same District as the President. If unwilling to accept, it would fall to the next level.
- 2. District Director with the most years on the Board. If unwilling to accept, it would fall to the next level.
- 3. District Director with the most consecutive (without gaps or lapses in membership), years of membership in the Club.
